Over the three days, **5,158** trade visitors from **47** countries attended the biennial exhibition, registering a **15%** increase from the 2016 edition. Industry professionals witnessed a wealth of innovations on the show floor, attended numerous product demonstrations, technical presentations and seminars, and shared work safety tips with **200** exhibitors from **20** countries.

The exhibition also welcomed a record number of visiting groups across various industry sectors, from schools and military units to human resources personnel, including Institute of Technical Education, the Republic of Singapore Navy, Ministry of Defence, SMRT, A*STAR as well as companies from the pharmaceutical, building and construction, offshore marine, facilities management and the electrical and electronic sectors. 


